



Safer Futures Service Offer during Covid-19 May 2020

Safer Futures provides support and recovery for people affected by domestic abuse and recovery for people affected by sexual violence. Safer Futures also provides education, and training for professionals.

We offer an integrated domestic abuse and sexual violence service across Cornwall and the Isles of Scilly for people of all ages regardless of gender. We accept self-referrals and professional referrals for all programmes.

A range of programmes are available from early intervention, crisis support, recovery and a behaviour change programme (Change4U), including the family programme (SUsie and Reconnect). Support includes one-to-one support workers, support groups, structured recovery groups, drop-ins and phone support.

Covid-19: Safer Futures have put contingencies in place to help maintain services. Whilst face to face contact with clients has stopped until further notice, help is available via the telephone, text, skype, email or other agreed social media platforms.

We are also running weekly virtual support groups, recovery toolkits and pre-booked sessions for adults and children, and those engaging in abusive behaviours.

All professional training is currently available via webinar and e-learning and is free of charge.
